Registration and technical/safety inspections will begin promptly at 7:30 AM. This is a great opportunity for you to learn more about your car, yourself, and to enhance your skills as a driver. **This is not a racing school.** Drivers will be assigned instructors. All drivers will be expected to remain well within the limits of their driving skills and to operate their vehicles responsibly and in a safe manner.

Event Headquarters will be the Holiday Inn, Beaver Falls at Exit #2, I-76 PA Turnpike. Call 800-259-8420 or 724-846-3700 for reservations. Rooms are being held under "Porsche Club" with a rate of \$91.00.

All Participants will be entered in a drawing for a free set of 4 Kumho Tires.

REQUIREMENTS

1. Helmet: Snell 1995 or newer.
2. Properly installed lap and shoulder restraint systems are mandatory. Student and instructor must have equal restraint systems.
3. Roll-over protection is mandatory for open cars. Cars with factory installed (OEM) built-in, roll-over protection are exempt from roll bar requirement; soft tops must be in the up position or hard top installed. Open cars without such OEM installation must have roll over protection (roll bar) properly installed. The "broom stick rule" will be used to determine eligibility. Arm restraints for open cars are highly recommended. Sunroofs must be closed and Targa tops installed.
4. Valid driver's license must be presented at tech.
5. Minimum 3/32 tread depth. No slicks. Tires must be DOT approved.
6. Applicants must be 18 years of age or older.
7. Clothing must be of natural material. Footwear must be enclosed, non-slip, with a relatively smooth sole. Hiking type shoes or deep or lugged soles are not permitted. No short pants permitted.
8. No open exhausts. 100 dbl limit (as measured from 50 feet)
9. Drivers are responsible for the preparation and condition of their vehicles. Completed tech form must be presented at tech inspection.
