## From The Driver's Seat

As I wrote last month, Lisa and I attended Parade in Salt Lake City, along with the Isleys and the Cryans. As promised, we did spend several hours at the Michelin Drive and Compare. This year, PCNA provided 2 Panameras for us

to drive through the modified autocross course. Although still apprehensive, Lisa is really beginning to enjoy this event too. We also spent some time watching the first day of autocross. In fact, when we arrived, the Porsche family members were just completing their time on the course, and we watched Ferdinand take 2 runs in a silver 991 cab. In the afternoon, I attended a discussion session with Tom Gorsuch, PCA National Treasurer, presented by Manny Alban and Dieter Landenberger, Manager of Historical Archives, on the latest exhibits at the Porsche Museum.

Thursday, Lisa and I participated in our first ever competitive national PCA event, the Gimmick Rally. Fortunately, we had a rental car, so Lisa could drive while I navigated. It was everything we expected, both fun and nerve-racking, since we wanted to do well. I am pleased to announce that not only were we still speaking when we completed the rally, but we actually received a trophy. Thursday afternoon was the Beer Tasting, and Thursday evening the Zone 4 Party. This year's party was attended by 32 people (by comparison, there were 10 people

at last year's party). A great showing considering Parade was in the west. Friday, we visited the Museum of Fine Arts exhibit. Speed: the Art of the Performance Automobile with Phil and Francine Kish from Rally Sport Region. The exhibit showcased 19 of the world's finest and fastest automobiles including Steve McQueen's Jaguar, Roberto Rossellini and Ingrid Bergmann's Ferrari 375mm, and several Bonneville speedracers including the 1952 Beast III, and the 1938 Mormon Meteor III, which holds more long distance speed records than any other automobile in history.

Saturday, we had to be at the parking lot at 7:30 a.m. to prepare for our Rennsport Driving Tour. A group of nearly 100 cars (mostly Porsches) caravanned 101 miles to the Bonneville Salt Flats where we actually drove out onto the speedway. From Bonneville we drove to the Miller Motorsports Park. Once there, we lined up and proceeded to take 2 Parade Laps around their track, which is the longest road racing facility in North America; it has 23 turns and is 4.486 miles. After lunch, we stayed and watched a little of the DE that had been organized to coincide with Parade. We returned to Salt Lake City iust minutes after the Parade of Porsches had departed. I was told that this year nearly 300 Porsches paraded up to and around the State Capitol, and back to the starting point. Saturday evening was the Victory Banquet. It is always so astonishing to me, how

Friday night there was a P2O welcome party at the 200 year old Buxton Inn (http://www.buxtoninn.com/). 










I had some self induced issues with this issue of the newsletter which explains why it is so late this month.

Flash your headlights at a fellow Porsche owner on the road!! Keep the kindred spirit alive!!


