Here's my story. I've always loved nice cars, and bought whatever looked like the next step up for me. Prior to my leap into Porsche, the last two were a BMW 6 Series coupe and a C6 Corvette convertible. My first Porsche was a 991 Carrera S, and just over a year later I moved on to a 991 GT3, which I loved. They were both great cars, but after a while I feel the need for a change, and I moved on to something Italian.







#### Technical Q and A

#### **Battery Trickle Chargers - 2016 Boxster GTS**

**Question**: Just purchased a 2016 low mileage Boxster GTS. Since this car will not be an everyday car and may sit at times for more than a few days should I invest in a battery trickle charger? If so what should I look for? and is hookup easy to do. Thanks

**Answer**: Submitted by Pedro Bonilla. Invest in a smart charger, not just a trickle charger. Smart chargers such as the CTEK, the Porsche (made by CTEK) and Scumacher among a few others actually monitor the charge of the battery and deliver the correct amount of electrical current and voltage without overcharging the battery.

Many trickle chargers just trickle charge continuously which in the end will shorten the battery's life.

#### 997 Instrument Cluster Replacement – 2006 911 Carrera 4S

**Question:** My 2006 997 C4S (6 manual) came with the red face dials on the instrument cluster, I'm not a huge fan. I've found a used cluster online off a 2007 manual 997 and was wondering if they're interchangeable. Note that my car is early and does not have TPMS whereas the one that I'm considering has the factory TPMS on the gauge face. I realize there'd be some programming involved with the mileage and such, but will there be issues with key coding or other things that I may not be considering? Any input is appreciated.

Answer: Submitted by Dustin Aydt [SVR]. Swapping a used instrument cluster into your vehicle is not as simple as some might think though it is possible. Using the factory Porsche system tester you cannot change the mileage that has been written into the cluster; this is to prevent swapping lower mile clusters into higher mileage cars. There are companies out there that can change the mileage in the replacement cluster to match the current mileage in your vehicle; this is the biggest obstacle to overcome from a technician standpoint. The vehicle coding/options can be written to the replacement cluster with the factory Porsche tester as well as some aftermarket testers. The options will need to be coded one-by-one and is a tedious process but it is necessary for all vehicle functions to operate properly and to prevent errant fault codes.

#### Do I need Winter Tires - 2017 718 Boxster S

**Question**: I am new to owning a Porsche. I have read I should not drive the summer tires during the winter as it can damage the tire when temps drop below 40. Is this true? It is not my daily driver so I am assessing if I need to invest in a set of winter wheels and tires to enjoy it on an occasional warmer winter day.

**Answer**: Submitted by Pedro Bonilla. More important than damage to the tire is damage to your car and/or you. Summer tire's compound is made to be "sticky" with warm temps. When exposed to temperatures lower than 40F the compound hardens and loses its ability to stick to the road and the car has very little traction. Also, cold temps can cause the compound on summer tires to crack and render them useless.

It is wise to have a second set of wheels shod with winter tires. These cars are great in the snow when using the proper snow tires.

## Do Porsche Rated Tires Need Flat Spot Wheel Chalks to Prevent Flat Spotting? - 2017 718 Boxster S

**Question**: Do Porsche rated tires need flat spot wheel chocks to prevent flatspotting? Recommended? Thanks in advance for the reply. Dont want to permanently flat spot my tires after 5 months of heated storage. Never had to do this on other Porsche's I've owned but this GTS has tires that are much more expensive than my Porsche's past.

**Answer**: Submitted by Pedro Bonilla. Porsche N-rated tires are really no different from non-N-rated tires in their behavior. If a car is parked for long enough time the tire will tend to flat-spot due to the floor. This flat-spotting is not permanent and does not damage the tires and will correct itself as the tires warm up and are driven a few miles. In order to lessen the effect, you may overinflate the pressure before storing the car for prolonged periods of time and/or you may use a softer landing (cradle) for the tires.

Don't forget to check and correct the tire pressures when putting the car in service again.
