Point System 2010 Introduction

The following are the new criteria for 2010 in order to receive points towards being recognized as the most active MVR member. This is an attempt to keep the program simple yet meaningful as it pertains to contributing to the success of MVR and Zone 4. Events outside of our region need to be reported by e-mail to the MVR Secretary at cpjmkrauser@juno.com. It is also important that event chairs report to the MVR Secretary those members who contributed, in a meaningful manner, to the success of any MVR event. An award for the most "Active" member based on the accumulation of points will be rewarded at the annual Holiday party. As in the past, MVR Officers will not be eligible to receive this Activities Award. This is always a work in process, so don't hesitate to send your comments and recommendations to the MVR Secretary to be presented to the awards committee which is comprised of the MVR Officers and Historian.
