



TECHNICAL Q&A

Is There a Way to Increase the Engine Revs To 700 At Idle – 1994 911 Carrera 2

Question: My engine revs read at slightly over 500 while on idle, on park the revs go up to 700. The oil pressure initially remains at normal but once the oil temp goes up to the halfway mark (9:00 o clock position on the gage) the oil pressure drops and the warning light comes on while the engine is at idle at 500 revs. Once the throttle is pressed or the car is placed on park thus increasing the revs to 700, the oil pressure comes back up and the warning light goes off. This problem started after the engine seals where replaced a few weeks ago.

Thank you for your question to the PCA!

There is a little-known procedure I have been teaching for about 15 years; it's called a System Adaptation. This procedure is performed with a Porsche Scan Tool called the Bosch Hammer, but there is one caveat, you must perform this procedure with the engine running at idle and a few electrical consumers turned on e.g., the headlights and the rear window defroster, this will raise the idle. If you turn on too many electrical consumers, the idle will be raised too high and the engine idle will surge grossly. This is simply fixed by performing another System Adaptation with fewer consumers chosen. I hope this helps.

Brake Rotor Replacement- 1990 944 S2

Question: Should I use slotted or drilled?

Answer: Submitted by George Beuselinck

Depending on the type of driving you are doing, slotted or drilled brake rotors might help, mostly for on track situations. The stock non drilled and non-slotted rotors

seem to work just fine. If you do choose drilled rotors, be aware that the holes in the rotors tend to be places that cracks tend to start and should be regularly inspected.

Air Filter Replacement – 2019 718 Cayman

Question: What Is Involved in Changing the Engine Air Filters?

To replace the air filters, some rear panels, trim pieces and carpeting need to be removed/relocated, as well as the DME box. This exposes the back end of the filter canisters and allows for replacement. You can search on YouTube where there are several good how-to videos on the subject and you can gauge for yourself.
