From The Driver's Seat

Greetings from Salt Lake City. Porsche Parade officially began at 9 a.m. on Sunday morning; it is amazing how much we have already done, and it's just the middle of the 3rd day. After registration, Lisa and I visited the con-

cours prep area. We always enjoy watching those extremely dedicated individuals as they finish up what is usually weeks if not months of painstakingly thorough preparation of their entries. We then explored the Goodie Store, which they graciously opened at 1:30 p.m. on Registration day, rather than making us wait until 9 a.m. on the first day of Parade. I "placed" my order, and then ran over to attend the PCA National Board Meeting; 2 1/2 hours later, the meeting ended, and it was time to get ready for the Welcome Banquet. This year's Welcome Banquet was held in a magnificent courtyard within the extremely elegant Grand America Resort. We wound up sitting with a group from Oregon and a couple from Illinois, and had a wonderful time.

The following day was the Concours and Car Corral. This year we had the opportunity to watch some vehicles being judged; it was amazing to see how thorough the judges are, inspecting every inch of the cars including the tool kits. Monday evening was the President's Reception, an invitation only event held at the charming La Caille Restaurant. During the course

of the evening, my friend Paul Gregor introduced me to Dr. Wolfgang Porsche and his son Ferdinand. Dr. Porsche and I spent 20-30 minutes conversing over cocktails. Later in the evening, my friend Michelle Juzeszyn introduced me and Lisa to Detlev von Platen, President and CEO of Porsche Cars North America

Tuesday, we took a fantastic tour to the Nish Speed Shop. During our visit, we met Mike Nish who holds a record at the Bonneville Salt Flats for driving his family's Royal Purple #998 Bonneville Streamliner 412.515 mph. Nish Motorsports has taken over 30 World Records, and Mike and his father Terry explained that they are working on breaking the record this September with the help of a Chrysler hemi engine that runs 50% nitro. After the speed shop, we travelled to Provo to visit Kirkham Motorsports facility. Dave Kirkham and his brother completely manufacture vehicles out of aluminum or copper. They specialize in Shelby Cobras, but are able to make any type of vehicle; in fact, they created a '40 GT out of pure copper for Ford, which was on display in their shop. Dave thoroughly walked us through the process of how the parts are fabricated in house and how the vehicles are assembled. He then showed us several vehicles in various stages of completion. The entire operation was truly remarkable.

There is still so much more ahead for us this week. The Isleys and Cryans are taking a couple of driving tours,






