Hard Shifting Into First And Reverse – 2004 Carrera 4

Question: I am having trouble shifting into 1st and into reverse. it requires a little more elbow grease than it should. Also, during a spirited drive—I find that periodically in shifting from 1st to 2nd, that the clutch will take a moment to engage. It's like the clutch is slipping prior to engaging.

The transmission fluid was changed at ~81K mile (<4K miles ago). I worry that this might mean my clutch is going bad. However, this problem just started-- can the clutch just all of a sudden fall off a cliff? From reading a few other posts here related to shifting troubles into first, this seems to be the solution to fixing this (if the transmission fluid has already been replaced). I don't know if the shifting into reverse issues mean anything different. Just confirming.

It sounds like your clutch is starting to go out. One way you may be able to tell is going out for a drive and put the car in 3rd or 4th gear going about 20 or so mph and then floor it. If the revs rise quickly and the car doesn't speed up then the clutch is slipping and needs to be replaced.

Should I Service Tiptronic Transmission - 2007 911 Carrera S

Question: I purchased my 2007 C2S in 2021 with 136k miles on it. It is a California car in great shape and it has been serviced at a Porsche dealer up until 120k miles. However, there are no records of the Tiptronic transmission being serviced at the 12 year/120,000 mile. Opinions seem to be split 50/50 whether the Tiptronic, which apparently is a MB sourced

transmission, should be serviced at all. My local dealer recommended servicing it but a reputable local Indy shop advised against it because it may start to slip. Searching for Tiptronic maintenance in the forums did not return many relevant answers. What would you advise I do?

That is a tough call, I personally don't like to service them over 100k miles if nothing has been done to it. If it's working well then, I would leave it alone.

Release Parking Brake Message in Multifunction Display— 2016 Cayman GT4

Question: I had the rear rotors and pads replaced last week at a local shop with stock OEM Porsche parts. They gave the car back to me with warnings they could not clear. The red brake warning light is flashing, the electric parking brake warning light is on and the release parking brake message is displayed on the multifunction display. I took it to a well-respected race shop today in my area and they could not fix it either.

The car drives normally, no resistance from the parking brake noted and the rotor hat cool in the area of the parking brake. Any insight as to what's going on?

Answer: Submitted by Pedro Bonilla

I've seen that happen when all 4 pads are down to minimum and the brake fluid level drops below the "minimum" on the reservoir. Since you had the rear pads replaced, check your brake fluid level to make sure it's correct. If it is, take it to a shop that uses a PIWIS unit to get the issue diagnosed. Happy Porsche'ing,


