

### MVR Business Meeting June 10, 2010

The following are notes from the subject MVR Business Meeting. In attendance were Todd Mierzwiak, Lisa and Michael Soriano, Rick Lederman, Bill Bauman, Shirley and Dick Gobba, Jeanne and Chris Krauser and Jason Perry from Vin Devers.

The proposed European Can Show at Vin Devers was discussed at length. Jason proposes to hold the show on Sunday September 19th and invite owners from all European countries to show their cars. It was agreed that more than likely most cars will come from Germany, Great Britain and Italy. Our goal is 80 to 100 cars. Cost to show a car will be \$8 if you register by September 17<sup>th</sup> or \$12 if you register the day of the event. There will be no cost to the general public. Owners will need to sign a waiver of liability during registration.

The show will open at 9AM and will conclude at 4PM. Prizes for People's Choice, 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> place will be awarded at 2PM. There will be two categories, one for votes cast by the attending public and one for votes cast just by participating owners.

Vendors will be invited to participate including, if available, car detailing, leather care, flexible clear car bras, wheels and tires and possibly other car products. Vin Devers will be showcasing their intentions to perform some of these duties or services where appropriate.

There will be a Hot Dog Vendor. Vin Devers will attempt to set up a small eating area with limited seating.

Tentatively, restrooms inside Vin Devers will be roped off for general use.

Vin Devers will attempt to put together a goodie bag to be given to each owner participant.

We need 10 to 12 MVR members to help move Vin Devers car inventory Saturday evening (after 6PM) to make room for show parking and to help with parking show cars and registration on Sunday. It will also be necessary to move Vin Devers car inventory back after show on Sunday. Anyone interested in helping should contact Todd Mierzwiak or Chris Krauser by September 1st please. MVR members helping on Sunday need to arrive by 8AM to get organized and to set up registration. Registration will start promptly at 9AM. If needed, Chris Krauser will provide pop up, table and chairs for registration.

All participating owners will be asked to bring chairs to which seems to be common practice so they can relax near their vehicle.

We will attempt to park cars by manufacturer as possible in a semicircular fashion with vendors set up in the middle. Final arrangements to be determined as we approach September.
