Porsches to MIS

A big Thanks goes to Lisa Soriano for forwarding an email from Dave Cooper from the Rally Sport Region - PCA in Michigan, inviting our club to do the Irish Hills road trip to MIS. As it worked out, Deb and I were open that weekend and jumped at the chance to drive on the Big Oval.

Everyone met at the Meijer's parking lot Ann Arbor and Dave led the drivers meeting, gave us the instructions, miles and time to each turn and off we go. What a beautiful day. The sun was shining, birds were singing and so was the Boxster. For about 1 hour we wound our way through the beautiful Irish Hills and finally finished at the entrance to the tunnels to get onto MIS. About 50 Porsches lined up in 3 rows before we were escorted through the tunnel, onto the infield and up to the gate of the paddock. We had about 1 hour to wait until the Richard Petty



Driving School stopped for lunch before we could take the track. The MIS safety director gave us our driving instruction for the track and when he said the MIS speed limit was 70 mph you could hear a pin drop. Rules were simple: stay out of lane #1, #6 (the wall) and no Passing.

Lisa/Michael Soriano asked me to comment on the insurance question: "does our car insurance cover us on the track?" The short answer is "Nope" the long answer is "Your car insurance covers you on <u>public roads</u>, not on a private race course, oval or road course made for racing or high speed driving". So, when you cross the public to private, your insurance stops at the gate. Also, there used to be a loophole a few years ago with the DE. Insurance would cover you on the course because you had a driving instructor in the car with you... that loophole was filled/ covered with the "private property used for practicing, racing or driving fast" exclusion.

Back to MIS, we got the OK to go and were allowed to cross the threshold into the paddock, pass by the Petty cars and into the first turn. We were the 8th car out of the paddock, hit the first turn about top down, windows up and accelerating out of the 2nd turn onto the straight-a-way and we had to slow down (we were not allowed to pass!). We hit the 3 & 4 turn and we were accelerating and passing cars still coming out of the paddock. Then again, got into line and could only go as fast as the car in front. The second lap was as much fun as the first but

unfortunately no faster (couldn't pass). Deb was laughing, yelling "go, go" and shooting photos all at the same time. She took a bunch of fantastic pictures. I couldn't believe the 6 laps were over when I saw the flashing lights on the safety truck waving us in.

After everyone was in, we were led to the exit and off we go to the Clark Lake Beach Bar where we had a private room with our own buffet. Everyone was still cranked up and talking about their laps. We sat with Jim and Cathy from the Rally Sport Region had a great time and made new friends

We've been fortunate this year to travel, spend time with and enjoy the people from the Maumee Valley Region and now the Rally Sport Region. The bottom line is this: We all like people, P-cars and fun. I can't think of anything better.






