



This summer has flown by, and I hope you have all had opportunities to get out and enjoy your cars. As I previously mentioned, in addition to being Maumee Valley Region President, I am the Parade Trophies Chair and my husband Michael is the PCA National Awards Chair. As a result, Michael and I spent much of July preparing for or attending Parade. The week of July 21, 2019, 1800 PCA members converged on Boca Raton, Florida, for the 64th Porsche Parade. The host hotel was the Waldorf Astoria's beautiful and historic Boca Raton Resort. Parade is PCA's weeklong celebration consisting of competitive and non-competitive events including Concours, Autocross, Time Speed Distance Rally, Gimmick Rally, RC Cars, Art Show, Tech Quiz, and 5K Run / Walk. Throughout the week there are tours, seminars, cooking presentations, beer and wine tastings, kid's activities, and even a Parade of Porsches. In addition, the National Awards: Enthusiast of the Year, Family of the Year, Region of the Year, the Zone Rep Award, Newsletter, Website, Membership, and Public Service Award winners are all announced during the week of Parade.

In between setting up for all of the banquets and handing out awards almost every day, we were able to participate in a tour. We visited Larry Wilson's Private Collection in Palm Beach. There were 3 rooms of incredible cars German and some English, American, and Italian, all of which are driven. Every one is in impeccable condition and some were rare and immaculately restored. Another morning we had time to get away and drove to the Palm Beach International Raceway for the Michelin Drive and Compare. Porsche brought two 718 Cayman GTSs that were run through an autocross course with an instructor to compare how the cars handle. The first Cayman GTS I drove was fitted with the new Michelin Pilot Sport 4S and the second Cayman GTS had the Continental Extreme Contact Sport tires. I could clearly feel the difference in the handling. On Thursday, our only day off, we competed in the Gimmick Rally. This year's theme was Spring Break. Competitors had to visit at least 6 of the 7 designated locations between Boca and Ft. Lauderdale, and answer questions or take pictures of items at each location. The locations included Butterfly World, Champion Porsche, the Bonnet House, The Elbo Room, Jaxson's Ice Cream, the Fort Lauderdale Antique Car (Packard) Museum, and the Swap Shop. As always, it was a fantastic but stressful day; we finished in a 7-way tie for 2nd Place.

To embrace the beach theme, Porsche Cars North America had several surfboards custom created each with an iconic livery on one side and the Parade Logo on the other side. At the end of the week, 3 of the boards were given to PCA to auction off with the proceeds going to the local region's favorite charity. On Friday night at the Autocross Banquet, Michael and

I helped to auction off the Gulf Livery surf board which sold for \$4500. This turned out to be a bargain. At Saturday night's Victory Banquet a bidding war for the Pink Pig surf board ended at \$7500. The crowd was then surprised when the Heritage surf board was offered. It sold for \$7100. In the end, \$19,100 was donated to the Joe DiMaggio Children's Hospital. It was another fantastic week of competitive events, driving tours, social hours, banquets, and camaraderie. After 10 Parades it is more like a family reunion, and a week that I look forward to every year. Next year's Parade is in Palm Springs, CA, from June 21-27, 2020.

At the end of July was MVR's DE at Grattan. A total of 80 participants thoroughly enjoyed themselves during the incident free weekend, which included a Ladies run group on Friday. Thanks to our sponsors: Porsche of Ann Arbor, Tireman, Erie Drug, Hagerty, Printingraphics, Pure Tuning, Stem Cell International, Toledo Shredding, Vin Devers, and Westgate Insurance. TECHNICAL Q&A

G50 G Box Oil - 1987 911 Carrera Targa

Question: My owner's manual says to use 90W in the G50 g'box (not LSD). Time has marched on, and now we have greatly improved lubricants from which to choose. I would like to use a full synthetic and am also interested in using a multi-grade oil such as an 85W-140. 90W-140, etc. for better protection in the summer heat. I will greatly appreciate your input.

- Subsequent to my initial post (paragraph above), I've found many with professional Porsche experience are saying that Mobil 1 Synthetic Delvac 75W-90 is the way to go. Any issues with that lubricant?

Answer - Submitted by Chris Powell: Delvac is certainly a good choice for that transmission. We also like LiquiMoly Fully Synthetic 75W-90.

Reusable Air Filter – 2011 Panamera Turbo

Question: I've experienced "seat of the pants" performance gains when replacing the factory filter with a more breathable reusable filter in BMW's and I never experienced issues related to the filter change through many years of ownership. When performing a service on my recently purchased 2011 Porsche Panamera Turbo at an independent mechanic's shop, I was told replacing the factory filter would not provide performance gains and the mass-airflow-sensor would eventually be affected (I assume from potential filter-oil entering the engine). Is this the case?

Answer - Submitted by Peter Smith: The airflow from a reusable will not help in the Panamera. The air filter is so big, I was told it's at 50% capacity when at full throttle. Also, the Panamera's don't use Air Mass sensors, they use a pressure sensor system now.

Mechanical Reliability - 2008 Cayman S

Question: Looking to purchase this vehicle and wanted feedback on reliability? Purchasing for track events.

Answer - Submitted by Pedro Bonilla: All Porsches when properly maintained according to the recommended service schedule are very reliable. Obviously, there are exceptions. For track use there are added demands placed on the engine,

transmission, suspension and brakes. If you will be running track on street tires no further changes are required, but if you intend to run on track compound or racing tires it's highly recommended that you look into engine oil starvation remedies, such as a deep oil sump, and/or an Accusump and also look into the IMS by at least removing the outer seal of the bearing or better yet, adding a Direct Oil Feed system to keep it lubed and cooled.


Battery Replacement – 2000 Boxster S

Question: I will be replacing the battery in my 2000 Boxster S. Is there anything "different" I need to do or be aware of? I have never replaced a Porsche battery, so I am not sure if it is as straight forward as replacing one in my domestic daily driver. Thank you for your answer.

Answer - Submitted by Pedro Bonilla: With the model year 2000 there's nothing special about replacing the battery other than the standard. Disconnect the negative side first, then the positive. When installing the new one, first connect the positive then the negative. Don't forget to secure it properly onto the battery tray and to connect the vent line. Happy Porsche'ing,
