The group from Alaska was not able to drive from home this year; however, a few of them still found a way to drive a Porsche to the event. They flew into Billings, Montana and borrowed a friend's. The new President and CEO of Porsche Cars North America, Kjell Gruner, was in attendance as were the President and CEO of Porsche Design of America, Karsten von Engeln and Head of Marketing for Porsche Design of America, Kerstin Hamann, and there was a slew of beautiful cars.

For those of you who are not familiar with Parade, it is a week of competitive events, seminars, driving tours, and other social activities designed with the entire family in mind; for many, it is a "Porsche Family" Reunion. Although we worked 14-16 hours most days, we found time and ways to connect with old friends and make new ones. After the banquets on Tuesday and Wednesday evening, we sat in the beautiful lobby of the French Lick Springs Hotel chatting with friends until late in the evening. I look forward to seeing you all at an event soon!





Porsche Literature by Sebastian Gaeta

"With Joe and Greg's permission I would like to begin a semiregular column showing some of the older Porsche literature"

Porsche specific literature has been a big interest of mine as far back as I can remember, especially the early stuff from the 50s and 60s. Whenever I read it I become immersed in a world in which I didn't even live. Born in 1962 I wasn't even around when most of my collection was produced and at best I was just a kid who was completely unaware of these cars and this hobby. But it still brings me back to a time I wish I had experienced which is why you will often see me hanging around with the "old-timers" at any Porsche events I attend.

With Joe and Greg's permission I would like to begin a semi-regular column showing some of the older Porsche literature in hopes of giving people who are unfamiliar with it a glimpse into the old days of Porsche.

I'll start with the oldest piece I have which is the earliest known book specifically about Ferdinand

Porsche called Porsche Autos-Weltrkorde. Written by Heinz Sponsel, it was published in 1953 and by its cover and title we might assume it has something to do with a speed record.











Although it is in German, with a little help from translators and following the illustrations I figured out that it is in fact a book about the Professor, Ferdinand Porsche, and his life's story culminating with the early 356's speed records set at Monthlery in 1951. https://porschecarshistory.com/1951-linas-montlhery-porsches-speed-records/

If you are not completely familiar with the elder Porsche's story and don't read German, I highly suggest reading Ludvigsen's Excellence Was Expected, it's not just the greatest Porsche book ever written but widely regarded as the finest automotive book ever. In it you'll learn about



Ferdinand's amazing early career as technical director for several companies before starting his own engineering firm. From trains, to tanks to farm implements and automobiles, his passion for anything mechanical and mobile was unmatched.


What we have in this particular book is an abbreviated biography relative to "Excellence" and because it is in German it makes it really just a collector's item for me, but being the earliest known book specifically about Porsche makes it very special indeed.
